Fatherhood has different meanings for all of us. This session will explore what has changed for fathers and hear your views on how services can work with fathers to support their roles as parents.

Knowhow is a NEW knowledge exchange session brought to you by the Centre for Excellence in Child & Family Welfare. The session will work like a discussion group bringing together those 'in the know' with those who have questions to talk about the central themes that impact the services that support children, young people and their families.

Our facilitator for the session is Scott Hall the Coordinator of Men and Family Relationships programs at the Sunshine Relationship Australia Victoria office. He works in partnership with Maternal Child Health, Local Councils, Kindergartens and Primary schools to coordinate parent programs that are father and family friendly. With a 25 year career working in early childhood and education, disability and mental health, hospital and University roles, he brings a wealth of experience to working with men and family relationships.

In the last 10 years Scott has worked extensively through agencies and his training service Learning Curve Consultancy, on many family based services that were beginning to engage Men and fathers more effectively. He brings a solid focus on achieving better outcomes for children and families, through strength based, universal and specialised work with men and fathers. Scott has also facilitated workshops across Victoria, and National conferences and training days in Perth, Adelaide, Newcastle and Cairns for example Family Relationships Services Australia 1st conference in 2008 and Men and Family Relationships National forum in 2009.
